## God, Our Father’s Standard for the Church

God seeks those who will believe Him, accept what He says as their standard:

Gen. 2:16-17, 3:1-6 Adam and the woman

Gen. 4:1-8 (See also Heb. 11:4, 1 Jn. 3:12) Cain & Abel

Gen. 22:12 (See also Rom. 4) Abraham

Deut. 8:2 Children of Israel

How about us?...

TIMOTHY – TITUS (“the faith” search):

1Ti 1:2 Unto Timothy, *my* own son in the faith: Grace, mercy, *and* peace, from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord.

1Ti 1:19 Holding faith, and a good conscience; which some having put away concerning (the) faith have made shipwreck:

1Ti 3:9 Holding the mystery of the faith in a pure conscience.

1Ti 3:13 For they that have used the office of a deacon well purchase to themselves a good degree, and great boldness in the faith which is in Christ Jesus.

1Ti 4:1 Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils;

1Ti 5:8 But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel.

1Ti 6:10 For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.

1Ti 6:12 Fight the good fight of (the) faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses.

1Ti 6:21 Which some professing have erred concerning the faith. Grace *be* with thee. Amen. *The first to Timothy was written from Laodicea, which is the chiefest city of Phrygia Pacatiana.*

2Ti 2:18 Who concerning the truth have erred, saying that the resurrection is past already; and overthrow the faith of some.

2Ti 3:8 Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, reprobate concerning the faith.

2Ti 4:7 I have fought a good fight, I have finished *my* course, I have kept the faith:

Tit 1:1 Paul, a servant of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God’s elect, and the acknowledging of the truth which is after godliness;

Tit 1:13 This witness is true. Wherefore rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the faith;

Tit 2:2 That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in (the) faith, in charity, in patience.

Tit 3:15 All that are with me salute thee. Greet them that love us in the faith. Grace *be* with you all. Amen. *It was written to Titus, ordained the first bishop of the church of the Cretians, from Nicopolis of Macedonia.*
