TIMOTHY - TITUS ("the faith" search):

- 1Ti 1:2 Unto Timothy, *my* own son in <u>the faith</u>: Grace, mercy, *and* peace, from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord.
- 1Ti 1:19 Holding <u>faith</u>, and a good conscience; which some having put away concerning (the) <u>faith</u> have made shipwreck:
- 1Ti 3:9 Holding the mystery of the faith in a pure conscience.
- 1Ti 3:13 For they that have used the office of a deacon well purchase to themselves a good degree, and great boldness in <u>the faith</u> which is in Christ Jesus.
- 1Ti 4:1 Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils;
- 1Ti 5:8 But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel.
- 1Ti 6:10 For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.
- 1Ti 6:12 Fight the good fight of (the) <u>faith</u>, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses.
- 1Ti 6:21 Which some professing have erred concerning the faith. Grace be with thee. Amen. The first to Timothy was written from Laodicea, which is the chiefest city of Phrygia Pacatiana.
- 2Ti 2:18 Who concerning the truth have erred, saying that the resurrection is past already; and overthrow the faith of some.
- 2Ti 3:8 Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, reprobate concerning the faith.
- 2Ti 4:7 I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith:
- Tit 1:1 Paul, a servant of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of the truth which is after godliness;
- Tit 1:13 This witness is true. Wherefore rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the faith;
- Tit 2:2 That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in (the) <u>faith</u>, in charity, in patience.
- Tit 3:15 All that are with me salute thee. Greet them that love us in the faith. Grace be with you all. Amen. It was written to Titus, ordained the first bishop of the church of the Cretians, from Nicopolis of Macedonia.
